# 2021 ANNUAL REPORT BE THECHANGE

The 2021 Annual Report aims to provide an overview of a successful year, organized by our 3 Strategic Plan Goals: Engage the Community, Meet the Need, and Sustainability. Our 2020-2025 Strategic Plan includes eight strategies to fulfill our mission: *Building stronger, healthier families in Idaho by providing access to basic hygiene to keep babies clean, dry and happy*.

## **Engaging the Community**

*IDB* actively collaborates with our community to help raise awareness of Diaper Need and to serve as a good community organization interested in strengthening Idaho Families.

Governor Little proclaimed the last week of September <u>Diaper Need Awareness Week in</u> <u>Idaho</u>. KTVB Channel 7 published a long feature. IDB hosted an Open House for the community.

JustServe, a volunteer website for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, was beneficial in providing hundreds of volunteers throughout the year. The mission statement was updated to be more reflective of the ongoing purpose of the organization.



## Meeting the Need

As IDB underwent strategic planning for the future, we re-focused our mission on diaper need for the 46% of Idaho's children under the age of three who live in low-income households.

## 4.6+ million diapers

distributed since 2014, distributing nearly 770,000 diapers throughout Idaho, serving the Treasure Valley, Northern Idaho and Eastern Idaho.

The main warehouse distributed nearly 630,00 diapers and pull-ups to 38 partners.

The Eastern Idaho Diaper Bank Alliance and its nine members distributed 172,000 diapers while the Northern Idaho Diaper Bank Alliance and its two members distributed 7,500 diapers.

Kimberly Clark-Huggies donated one semi-load of diapers. In addition, IDB received nearly 70,000 items valued at over \$40,000.



Seventeen cloth diapering kits were given to moms throughout Idaho who applied to receive the kits via the IDB website.

The IDB purchased over 462,000 diapers, pull-ups and wipes during the year.

Idaho Diaper Bank received excess Size 1 diapers from Kimberly-Clark truckloads over the past few years, and we donated 5 pallets in 2021, approximately 50,000 diapers, to the Utah Diaper Bank with gratitude to Great Floors for delivering them on their truck.
