IDB continues to engage the community and spread awareness on diaper need in Idaho with our social media platforms and with our community group associations. Now we'd like to ENGAGE YOU to help us find the next Executive Director to continue Idaho Diaper Bank's mission to building stronger, healthier families in Idaho by providing access to basic hygiene to keep babies, clean, dry, and happy. This is a part-time, contract position, both remote and in person with flexible hours.

Strategic Pillar: Meeting the Need

IDB distributed 147,000 helping over 3500 babies from the Warehouse.

Eastern Idaho Diaper Bank Alliance distributed 34,285 diapers to their partners helping 767 babies.

Purchased 171,760 diapers, pull-ups and wipes.

Nearly 30,000 Gifts in Kind were donated valued at \$9500. This included 680 packages of wipes from the local Amazon warehouse.


